


# The North-West Prospect of Cape-Coast Castle.

North which (the very near y Equinoctial Line) yet is it accounted y most wholsome dir in Guinea Under Shelter of y Guns, is built a Large Populous Negro Town The People are of a Warlike Sort, Their Religion is altogether Pagan Their Litish day or Salbath, is on Tuesday Their Chief provision is Fish & Canky (before described in plate 14) Neverthelefs y Castle is indifferently Stored with Mutton, Goats, Hogs, & Fowles, from y'Inland Country also some Venison, but at a very dear Rate.




- ST MARK (Captain: Peter Solgard)
- Sailed from London in 1713
- Arrived on the West African Coast in 1714
- Docked at Cape Coast Castle
- Left Africa with 280 enslaved people on board
- Arrived in Kingston, Jamaica with 261 enslaved people on board
- Ten per cent of the enslaved were children on this voyage






